On the 4th July till 25th July 2009 Malaysian Pharmacy Student's Association (MyPSA) had conducted a programme called Student Exchange Program (SEP). The person in charge for this programme is Mr. Haikal Madzhi, the Student Exchange Officer (SEO) for MyPSA. Student Exchange Programme (SEP) is one of the main activities in International Pharmaceutical Student's Federation (IPSF).



Currently, close to 50 associations throughout the world participate in SEP and over 500 international exchanges take place every year.

It is a mobility programme that gives students from all over the world the opportunity to get to know pharmacy in a different country. Currently, close to 50 associations throughout the world participate in SEP and over 500 international exchanges take place every year.

This year is the first ever year for MyPSA to conduct this grand project. We hosted 6 students (3 from Indonesia, 2 from Czech Republic and 1 from Hungary).
